

NEW LAND ADJACENT PLAYGROUND

As mentioned at the last meeting the Parish Council has to decide what to do with the piece of land it has been given adjacent to the playing field. The Parish Council consider that the original idea to extend the existing football pitch is no longer an option because a) we do not have a football team and b) there are no changing facilities. This leaves the question – “What to do with the land?”

It is a very irregular cheese-wedge shape, measuring approximately 60metres across and 15 metres wide at one end tapering down to 5 metres wide at the footpath end. The Parish Council consider that the options would be to either a) develop the land into a woodland walk or something similar or b) sell it to the developer or a neighbouring property and put the money to something else in the village.

The Parish Council would welcome any feedback from residents on the future of the land. Please forward ideas/thoughts to the Parish Clerk. It would be useful if we could have some feedback by our next meeting on the 5th December.
