DRINKSTONE EDUCATIONAL CHARITY

Did you know that there used to be a school in Drinkstone? When it was closed (July, 1986) and sold, the money from the sale was used to set up a charity and the interest on that money is used to support Drinkstone residents for educational purposes.

The charity is run by a small committee of Drinkstone residents, which meets 3 times a year to discuss applications and make financial awards.

Might you need support for education – awards have previously been given to university students, mature students undertaking vocational courses, school students undertaking a World Challenge trip, many of the clubs and classes that happen in the village and lots of other applicants, all broadly educational!
