Report for Annual Parish Meeting 14th May 2018

Drinkstone Educational Charity, year ending December 2017

The Drinkstone Educational Charity was set up following the closure and sale of Drinkstone School. The money from the sale was used to set up a charity and the interest on that money is used to support Drinkstone residents for educational purposes.

All residents of Drinkstone can apply for funding for broadly educational activities, from university students to mature students, vocational courses to World Challenge trips and much more.

In the year ending 31 December 2017, the Educational Charity had an income of £2510, and awarded £1459 to both village activities and individual residents.

Over 75% of the awards were to fund the Village activities, including the cost of hiring the Village Hall for Junior Youth Club, Senior Youth Club and the Local History Group. Plus the cost of insurance necessary to run the Youth Clubs.

There were also awards towards books for a university student and an award towards research into the names mentioned on the Drinkstone War Memorials.

The trustees of the Charity are continually aware of the importance of actively promoting the Charity within Drinkstone village to encourage applications. For example, a summary of each meeting of the trustees is published in the Parish Magazine and a flyer was delivered to all houses in the village. In addition, the Charity has a section on the village website giving access to download the application.

The accounts for the year ending 31st December 2017 have been examined by Lionel Denny, a retired Barclays Bank Manager who lives in Woolpit. Investment income for the year was £2510 and as already referred to grants totalled £1459 leaving us with a balance in Barclays Bank of £3348. . Outstanding grant commitments at the year end were £1240.

Endowment Fund - three new investments were made at a cost of £44275 following the liquidation of two of the original holdings. Balance sheet value of the Endowment Fund is now £61625 and valuation as at 31st December 2017 £81278.
