General

The footpaths are all passable, albeit being very wet and muddy in places. Should we address the mud by putting down wood-chips/hay/straw? I notice on FP20, the landowner has used hay to make the footpaths less muddy - I have plenty of this, would it be a good idea to spread some?

Footpath 14

There is a small section of this footpath that is lower-lying and therefore puddles excessively. The water is over ankle height and there is no dry area where you can pass. This issue happens every year. Could we install something here to sort this problem out?

Broken Bridge - Footpath 23

The bridge where FP23 meets Rattlesden Road has collapsed at one end. This has been reported to MSDC for repair.
