Agenda Item; <u>Councillor Portfolios</u> During the last month I have visited the Playing field and have found some evidence of dog fouling. This is clearly unacceptable and hopefully the new signs around the village will start to take effect. The play equipment is still in a serviceable condition, with minor repairs needed. I have prepared a list of parts required with costings, these are:-

Swing bushes £ £24 -00

Rhino Board (mound slide ramp) f 125 - 00

Half round rail(mound slide ramp) £ 11-00

Total £ 160 - 00 plus VAT.

Unfortunately we will have to buy a whole sheet of Rhino, smaller sheets are not available.

The Defibrillator is in a state of readiness, and The Circuit has been regularly updated in accordance.

I have been approached by a member of the public to ask if the Kiosk can be used as a magazine exchange also. There are several magazines already in the kiosk, though they never seem to be removed or changed.

2 more benches have been approved by the landowner for erection on footpath 4 that runs behind Hall Farm. I am due to have a meeting with Robert Baker to decide the suitable locations (though he is very busy with harvest at the present time. I am awaiting his instruction.
