FOOTPATHS

No major issues to report.

Footpaths continue to be accessible although some are very wet and muddy at present. Minor trimming of brambles on some paths has taken place.

The dog waste bin post at the beginning of footpath 6 [opposite Chapel Lane] has rotted and fallen over. Someone has kindly tied it to the footpath post so it is still useable but this post needs to be renewed.

Consideration should also be given, cost permitting, to installing some additional bins at other locations

Suggestions include the junction of Deadmans Lane and Hill Farm Lane [footpath 7]. This is a very popular route used by Drinkstone and Woolpit residents and is about half way round a well used circular route.

Another location is close to Hill Farm itself, the beginning/end of footpath 8 which is the route to Rattlesden.

Suggestions for other locations are welcome.
