Agenda Item 14: Allotments

I have now received a new password to enable me to go onto the Charities Commission Web site. I have filed the Annual Return and added myself and Joyce Cocksedge as Trustees.

Historically the allotments have been managed with minimum input from the trustees. I suggest we define the role of trustees and seek their involvement in the management of the allotments futuristically. In the current copy of the Management Policy items six and seven have been crossed out. I propose we look at items six and seven with a view to reinstatement following which I can send a copy of the approved Management Policy to each trustee.

6. The Council will consult if it is considering any substantial changes to the allotment management policy or the tenancy agreement.
7. The trustees will be responsible for the following:
 - a. resolving tenant disputes.
 - b. notifying the Council of non-cultivation of plots.
 - c. consulting tenants on the Councils behalf on any substantial changes to the allotment policy or tenancy agreement, and advising the Council.
