- a. I have not received any complaints this month regarding “Dog Fouling” on the park. Good news is that during my weekly visits I have not come across any instances of fouling.
- b. I attended a Routine Play Equipment Inspection Course, organised by SALC and held at the Stowmarket council chambers. This also included an examination to be awarded the RPII certificate. I found this to be a very interesting and informative course.
- c. During the annual inspection it was noted in the report that now the matrix safety matting had been lifted and reinstated under the swing sets, that the swing seats are at an incorrect height and need to be adjusted. This has now been done. (correct height 400mm-500mm)
- d. Also during my weekly visits I noticed one of the wooden footsteps on the small climbing frame had come loose, this has been repaired.
- e. I have walked the playfield and performed my own weekly playground equipment inspections and found no problems other than mentioned above.
