### **Report to the Ordinary Meeting Dated 4th November 2019**

#### **Agenda Item; Councillor portfolios**

##### **General**

As of 21 October there are 3 open highways issues logged on the Suffolk Highways website; vis.

1. Condition of White Lines at jcn of The Street and Beyton Road. Suffolk CC status has changed from "Routine Inspection Ordered" to the works being planned, which will be completed within 14 weeks. This places completion approximately 11 Nov 2019.
2. Potholes adjacent to Great Barn, only recently reported
3. Potholes on Rattlesden Road, only recently reported.

1. Near Church

5. Jcn Rattlesden Road and Cross Street.

All bins at these locations are full I have not had an opportunity to check the bin at Jcn Beyton Road and The Street, but will do so shortly and report to the council verbally

The next stage is for the Council to decide on proceeding or not, to decide upon quantity and functionality and to apply for Suffolk CC grant.
