Report to the Ordinary Meeting Dated 11th January 2021

During the last month I have visited both sets of allotments and can report that the general condition is good on both sites with no maintenance required although the wet December has made the land very wet.

The compost bins for Rattlesden Road allotments were purchased, assembled and are now in situ on the allotments. I managed to find the same bins on Amazon cheaper, the final cost being £229.94 as opposed to £339.95.

A second hand ATCO 19SE with electric start lawn mower has been purchased for the Gedding Rd allotments for £150.

The large Ivy tree by the smaller gated entrance to the Gedding Road allotments has now been removed and replaced with native hedging.

We need to prepare and issue invoices for the next growing year commencing April 2021, to ensure that any plots which are no longer required are identified and let before the season begins.
