### **1. Defibrillators**

Both village defibrillators have been checked and are in working order.

#### **Village Hall Defibrillator:**

- The current pads are due to expire in November 2025.
- Replacement pads have been ordered, received, and installed.
- As advised by the East of England Ambulance Service, I conducted a diagnostic check to determine if a software update was required. The unit is fully up to date and compliant with current NathLink standards.

### **First Aid & Basic Life Support Training**

An Expression of Interest was circulated for community First Aid and Basic Life Support sessions.

- So far, five residents have responded positively.
- I will now liaise with West Suffolk Hospital and/or the Community Heartbeat Trust to explore available course options.
- Once confirmed, I will advertise the session details and date in the Parish Council newsletter to encourage wider participation
